Dear Parents/Carers,

Happy 2nd of December! The children are so excited! I wanted to write with some updates and to explain some of our Christmas arrangements for December.

With guidelines constantly changing with Covid at the moment these dates and arrangements are all subject to change depending what happens with local cases and DfE guidance. I will ensure that if changes are made you are updated as soon as possible.

Christmas Tree Festival – our children have decorated Christmas trees which will be on display at St Barnabas church on Friday 3rd December for children and families to visit between 2pm – 4pm. Why not pop along during Inset day to see all of the beautiful trees and decorations.

Christmas Jumper Day – Friday 10th December –

All children are invited to wear a Christmas jumper/outfit on this day. On this day we ask that all children bring into school an item for our raffle hampers such as treats, chocolate, crisps, sweets, crackers etc. We are planning to create ‘coloured hampers’ see the picture attached so if you could stick to the colours – red, blue, yellow/gold, green and purple.



Christmas Fair – Monday 13th December 3:15pm – 4:15pm

This year we will be holding our Christmas fair outside on the playground. The children will be busy making crafts to sell at their Christmas stall and there will be hot chocolate and mince pies too. The school choir will also perform a few Christmas songs and we will hold our treat hamper raffle. If you have any **good quality games/toys/books** that you would like to donate for a bring and buy sale table please bring these and leave them in the office.

EYFS Nativity – Tuesday 14th December 2pm and Wednesday 15th December 9.30am

We still hope to be able to hold our EYFS nativity but this may need to change if guidance changes or Covid cases in school increase.

For the moment the plans are as follows – parents will be asked to choose one performance and to reduce numbers only 2 people will be able to attend per child. We will well ventilate the hall and



socially distance the seating as much as possible. Closer to the date you will be asked to select the date you will attend.

Christmas Party Day – Thursday 16th December – Children will be able to wear their party clothes all day and school will provide some party snacks for them to enjoy during the afternoon.
