



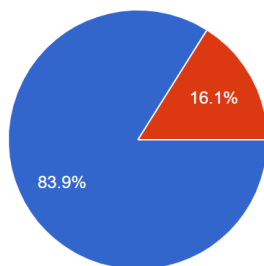
Pupil Voice Autumn 2 – 2021-2022

I feel safe at Sunnyside.

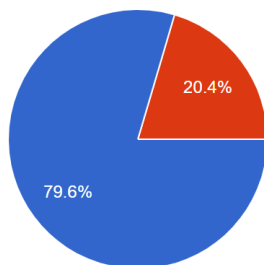

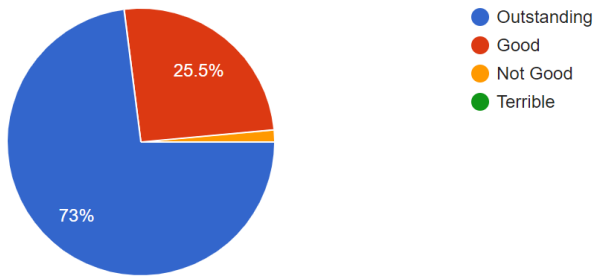

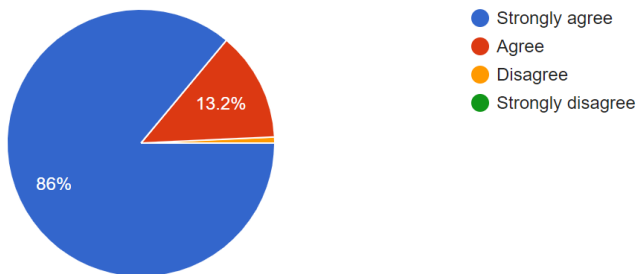
Behaviour at Sunnyside is:

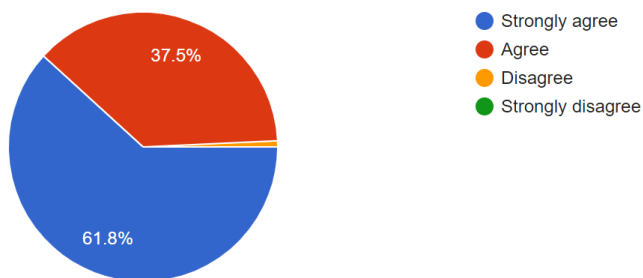
I know what the school rules are.

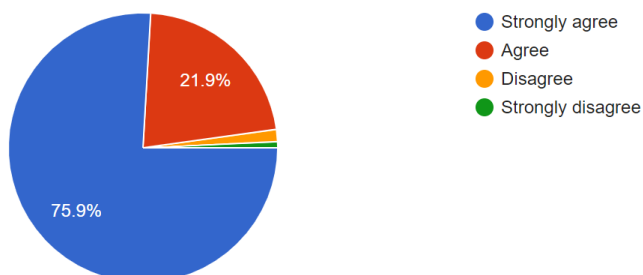
I am proud of the behaviour of children at Sunnyside.

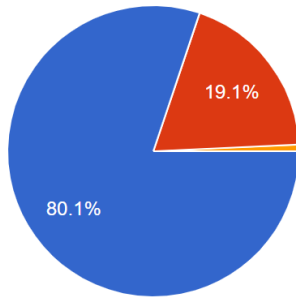

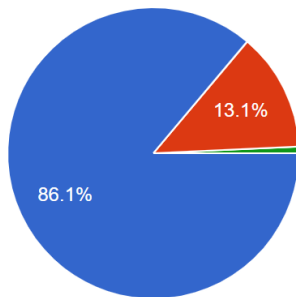

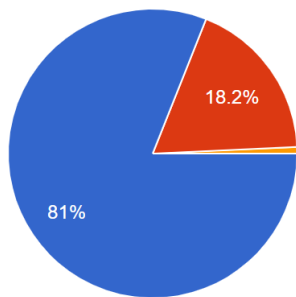

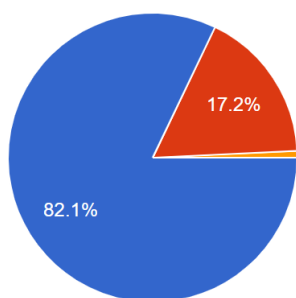
